## Lockdown in Victoria

Restrictions under Victoria's new circuit-breaker actions will end tonight. From 11:59pm 17 February 2021 Victoria returns to COVIDSafe Summer restrictions – with some revised conditions.

There will no longer be four reasons to leave home and the five-kilometre restriction will no longer apply. Schools, restaurants and retails can reopen and both public and private office workers can return up to 50 per cent on site.

There are a number of revised conditions that will continue for another nine days until Friday 26 February, subject to public health advice.

These include:

Limiting visitors to your home to five people per day

Limiting public gatherings with friends and family to 20 people

Limiting visitors to hospitals and aged care facilities to one household per day with some specific exceptions.

## **End of Lockdown in Victoria**
